Background

In the fall of 2019 the City of Richmond began a process to develop a new city wide participatory budgeting process. The goal of this new initiative is to center the community in making decisions about public funding. In Spring 2023, the RVAPB Steering Committee completed a rulebook that sets the guide rails for this effort to start in 2024.

Project
